AN IMPORTANT NOTE TO PARENTS/GUARDIANS REGARDING Education Code Section 49423:

Medications (both prescription and non-prescription) to be administered at school require **BOTH** the physician's signature and parent/guardian signature authorizing designated school personnel to dispense such medication. *Please obtain a PERMISSION TO GIVE MEDICATION form from the School Secretary if your child is required to take medication during the regular school day.* All medications, excepting those which must be kept on the student's person for emergency use, must be kept and distributed by staff. *Medication must be brought to school in the original container with printed instructions on the label.*

<u>LUNCH AND LUNCH CHARGES:</u> Please order and pay for lunches in the *school office* each morning. Lunches are \$3.25. We again ask that children not charge lunches unless absolutely necessary due to the fact that numerous charges made last year were not paid. If your child must charge a lunch, please send a written note with your child requesting a charge. Thank you very much!

BREAKFAST: Freshwater offers a breakfast program each morning from 7:45-8:20 a.m. **The cost is \$1.00 or less if you qualify for free or reduced meals**

<u>ABSENCES AT FRESHWATER SCHOOL:</u> When your child is ill or absent, please take time to contact the school office **in the morning** to let us know. It saves us making many phone calls to verify these absences each day. Thank you!
