TARDIES AT FRESHWATER: We have great numbers of students arriving to school late each day. When a student is late to school, he/she must stop by the office for a Late Slip causing Mrs. Mintey to write numerous Late Slips each day. This also causes the student(s) to be late to class sometimes missing very important morning instructions as well as disrupting a class of students that has already started working on assignments. Please make every effort to get your child to school on time each day! *<u>NOTE</u> **REGARDING BREAKFAST:** STUDENTS ARRIVING AFTER 8:15 a.m. IN THE MORNING AND NEEDING BREAKFAST WILL BE GIVEN FOOD ITEMS THAT THEY MAY TAKE WITH THEM TO THE CLASSROOM SO AS NOT TO BE LATE FOR THE START OF CLASS!!

SPORTS PHYSICALS: A reminder to parents that if your child is planning to play any sports this year, he/she will be required to have a Pre-Sports Physical prior to playing. It is your responsibility to arrange for a physical for your child before he/she can participate in athletics at Freshwater School. LUNCH AND LUNCH CHARGES: Please order and pay for lunches in the <u>school office each morning or</u> <u>may also pay in advance</u>. Lunches are \$3.25. We again ask that children not charge lunches unless absolutely necessary due to the fact that charges do not always get paid. If your child must charge a lunch, please send a written note with your child requesting a charge. Thank you very much!

PACK AN EXTRA SNACK: Many students are coming to school needing an additional snack, and we do not offer a school-wide snack program. Check in with your child to see if they would like you to send an extra snack with them. As our students grow, so do their appetites. When choosing foods, please consider healthy snacks that are high in protein, fiber, and vitamins to give your child sustained energy throughout the day. THANK YOU!

BREAKFAST: Freshwater offers a breakfast program each morning from 7:45-8:20 a.m. **The cost is \$1.00 or less if you qualify for free or reduced meals.**

<u>ABSENCES AT FRESHWATER SCHOOL</u>: When your child is ill or absent, please take time to contact the school office **in the morning** to let us know. It saves us making many phone calls to verify these absences each day. Thank you!

LABEL YOUR CHILD/CHILDREN'S CLOTHING: Please be sure to put your child/children's names inside all of their new school sweatshirts and jackets. Many were not claimed last year and have been donated to local charities. Also, be sure to check the school dress code when purchasing clothes for your child.

AN IMPORTANT NOTE TO PARENTS/GUARDIANS REGARDING Education Code Section 49423: Medications (both prescription and non-prescription) to be administered at school require BOTH the physician's signature and parent/guardian signature authorizing designated school personnel to dispense such medication. Please obtain a PERMISSION TO GIVE MEDICATION form from the School Secretary if your child is required to take medication during the regular school day. All medications, excepting those which must be kept on the student's person for emergency use, must be kept and distributed by staff. Medication must be brought to school in the original container with printed instructions on the label.
