HELP KEEP OUR STUDENTS SAFE!: Once again, we are concerned about unsafe driving in our parking lots. For the safety of our students, we are asking parents to be careful and exercise caution when dropping off and picking up students at Freshwater School. In the front parking lot, a single lane is to be used for drop-off in the morning and two lanes may be used in the afternoon with teachers walking students to cars in the second lane. In the gym parking lot, parents are to park in spaces and walk over to pick up their children to prevent unsupervised students from walking out into the parking lot. Also, please do not line up behind parked cars which will not allow the parked cars room to back out when they are prepared to leave. We have had some close calls in the parking lots and we do not want anyone to get hurt. As a result of these ongoing concerns, a Freshwater Traffic Safety Committee is being formed to improve roadway safety conditions on both Greenwood Heights and Freshwater Road.
