FRESHWATER INSTRUMENTAL MUSIC PROGRAM RECEIVES \$6000 GRANT FROM ROTARY CLUB OF EUREKA:

Approximately 20% of the students in our school participate in the Freshwater Instrumental Music Program, and all of the FCMS students participate through our FCMS World Music Program (samba band and steel drum bands). We are fortunate to be able to provide instruments to the majority of our students. While the Freshwater Band voluntary Family donations cover the cost of repair and maintenance of our instruments, they do not allow for the purchase of new or replacement instruments, and many of the instruments in our inventory are over 15 years old and nearing the end of their limited life-span. **We are, therefore, very pleased to announce the receipt of a \$6000 grant from the Rotary Club of Eureka through the Sign and Ruth Smith Fund Grant! Thank you to Chris Jioras who took the initiative to write this winning grant—we are very grateful for her ongoing support of the Freshwater Music Program.** We are using these funds to purchase new or gently used instruments and to put money towards the purchase of a Marimba One marimba. **Thank you Rotary Club of Eureka!**
