Birth Certificate 2. Immunization Record (California law requires that students are up to date on all required immunizations or That they have a medical waiver signed by a licensed physician) 3. CDHP Well Child Exam – Completed within 18 months of entering First Grade (Form given to you when you receive your registration packet), 4. Oral Health Assessment (Form given to you when you receive your registration packet). Children entering Kindergarten **MUST TURN AGE 5 ON OR BEFORE SEPTEMBER 1.**
