PARKING IN GYM LOT SPACES DURING AFTER SCHOOL PROGRAM HOURS: The parking spots that are reserved for the After School Program pick-ups are being used by parents who are NOT picking up students from the ASP. <u>NAMES ON PERSONAL ITEMS:</u> Please help us by putting your child's name on personal items such as jackets, sweaters, sweatshirts, hats, lunchboxes, backpacks, etc. If these items are found outside on the playground, on benches, at daycare, etc., we will try to get them back to the students <u>IF THERE ARE NAMES ON THEM.</u>

<u>OVERDUE LUNCH CHARGES:</u> We still have many overdue lunch charges which need to be paid. Please contact Mrs. Mintey to see what your balance is and bring your payment into the office as soon as possible. Lunch charges must be paid in full prior to any further charging privileges. Thank you.

<u>INDEPENDENT STUDY:</u> When you know that your child(ren) will be missing <u>5</u> or more days of school, you have an option to request an Independent Study. Missing school can impact a child's learning as well as school funding. Requesting an Independent Study Packet can help keep students from falling behind on work and will also prevent the school from losing state funding. In order to request an Independent Study Packet, you must fill out the Independent Study Master Agreement **AT LEAST TWO DAYS PRIOR TO LEAVING** and it must be signed by the student, parent/guardian, teacher and principal. The work must be turned in on the day the student returns to school. If you have any questions, please contact the school office.

STUDENTS LEAVING FOR APPOINTMENTS DURING THE DAY: Please note that when it is necessary for you to take your child early from class for an appointment, it is our policy that we will call your child to leave when you arrive in the office to sign him/her out. ## AN IMPORTANT NOTE TO PARENTS/GUARDIANS REGARDING Education Code Section 49423:

Medications (both prescription and non-prescription) to be administered at school require **BOTH** the physician's signature and parent/guardian signature authorizing designated school personnel to dispense such medication. *Please obtain a PERMISSION TO GIVE MEDICATION form from the School Secretary if your child is required to take medication during the regular school day.* All medications, excepting those which must be kept on the student's person for emergency use, must be kept and distributed by staff. *Medication must be brought to school in the original container with printed instructions on the label.*
