The site council is responsible for providing input on the Comprehensive School Safety Plan, reviewing the District Wellness Policy, serves as an advisory committee for the Local Control and Accountability Plan (LCAP), and undertakes other district wide projects the council deems appropriate. Two parent/guardian seats are up for reelection to begin the 2022-2023 school year. The council meets at least three times a year at Freshwater School.
