AN IMPORTANT NOTE TO PARENTS/GUARDIANS REGARDING Education Code Section 49423

Medications (both prescription and non-prescription) to be administered at school require **BOTH** the physician's signature and parent/guardian signature authorizing designated school personnel to dispense such medication. Please obtain a PERMISSION TO GIVE MEDICATION form from the School Secretary if your child is required to take medication during the regular school day. All medications, excepting those which must be kept on the student's person for emergency use, must be kept and distributed by staff. Medication must be brought to school in the original container with printed instructions on the label.
