AN IMPORTANT NOTE TO PARENTS/GUARDIANS REGARDING Education Code Section 49423
 Medications (both prescription and non-prescription) to be administered at school require

 personnel to dispense such medication. ***Please obtain a PERMISSION TO GIVE MEDICATION***
form from the School Secretary if your child is required to take medication during the regular

in the original container with printed instructions on the label.
