SCHOOL SAFETY PROTOCOLS: When Freshwater School went into lockdown last week it provided a good opportunity for our staff, students, and parents to put our emergency protocols into place. We always take time to reflect on what went well and where we can improve when following our Emergency Operations Plan. Our staff and students did an excellent job staying calm while locking down and waiting for the **ALL CLEAR** signal to be given. Our Freshwater families also did a great job of waiting to receive emergency notifications sent from Freshwater via email and text and also **NOT** calling or coming out to the school during an emergency. Though it is a guardian’s first instinct to want to check on their child(ren), **we ask you to always standby and wait for emergency communications sent from the school before acting. Then, only come to school if directed to do so.** Unexpected arrivals and phone calls hinder our emergency response efforts and potentially puts you and others at risk. If for any reason you **DID NOT** receive the emergency texts/emails sent last Thursday during the lockdown, please call Brenda Flores in the front office to verify the phone number that we have listed for your family. It is extremely important that the phone numbers on file in the office remain up to date so that you will receive important information during an emergency. Again, thank you for your cooperation and support in helping to keep our school community safe.

AN IMPORTANT NOTE TO PARENTS/GUARDIANS REGARDING Education Code Section 49423

Medications (both prescription and non-prescription) to be administered at school require **BOTH** the physician's signature and parent/guardian signature authorizing designated school personnel to dispense such medication. ***Please obtain a PERMISSION TO GIVE MEDICATION form from the School Secretary if your child is required to take medication during the regular school day.*** All medications, excepting those which must be kept on the student's person for emergency use, must be kept and distributed by staff. ***Medication must be brought to school in the original container with printed instructions on the label.***
